

ICC PET POLICY SUMMARY

The following is only a summary of the ICC's Pet Policy. Please see Standing Rule 8.5 for more details.

1. **Black Elk, Linder, Luther, Osterweil, Owen, Truth, Renaissance** and **King** are all pet friendly houses. Pets, including caged pets, may reside only in houses designated as "pet friendly." Fish are allowed in tanks of 20 gallons or less in any house and do not require approval or a pet addendum.
2. New members must get approval for a pet they plan to bring BEFORE they sign a contract.
3. All pets must be approved by the house or suite before the pet is allowed into the house.
4. 85% of the members voting at a regularly scheduled house meeting need to approve the pet in order for the pet to be allowed into the house.
5. A pet addendum to the pet owner's contract must be completed before the pet is allowed to reside in the house.
6. All vaccination documents, spay-neuter verifications and proof of insurance must be completed before the pet is allowed to reside in the house.
7. Dog owners must obtain renter's insurance to insure against liability and damages caused by the dog.
8. Pet-owning members will be charged \$30.00 per month during the time the pet resides in the ICC.

Additional Notes

1. There are limits on the total number of pets allowed per house and per room: No more than one dog per house and no more than one uncaged pet or two caged pets per room.
